

Defining Journalists Outlook Alok Mehta

It is a story of a boy who began his expedition of life from Ujjain as a misnomer. But by his resilience and hardship earned a distinction among the giants of journalism. No matter if it was Nai Duniya from where he started as a toddler or joining the reputed office of Outlook, his zeal remains intact. He has the reputation of being a proud part of almost all popular Hindi dailies. **Devesh Charan** tried to 'Encounter' with the unexplored personality of **Alok Mehta** - Editor Outlook Saptahik.

Despite a humble beginning, Alok has successfully managed the office of Outlook Saptahik (weekly) magazine. To his credit has been the coveted designation like being General Secretary of Editors Guild three, being hi-profile anchor. It was he who was chiefly involved with the conceptualization of popularly watched programme *Encounter* telecasted at Zee News channel.

Like every other ordinary guy this son of a school teacher strived for study in the remote areas of Madhya Pradesh. But the same chip with tremendous latent abilities made sure that the world does take notice of his true worth. This man of self belief has always tried hard to

rulefine Hindi journalism. Some of his peers consider him as an institution in himself.

Collecting, collating, presenting and disseminating information is key success areas for any journalist. This is precisely where many journalists either gain or lose competitive advantage. Alok Mehta is a man who knows his art and continuously servicing the media for last 32 years without getting biased towards anyone. Born in Ujjain (M.P) on 7th September 1952, Mr. Mehta did his M.A. in Modern History from Vikram University (Ujjain). His career steadily moved up the ladder. He bestowed his journalistic neuron to almost all the leading newspapers and

magazine and with the advent of electronic media he has just left it untouched. He was Executive Editor, Hindustan Delhi from 1994 to September 2009. Then he joined Dainik Bhaskar group as editor before being offered the position of debut Editor in Outlook Saptahik. The Saptahik under him is steadily capitalizing on the readers and giving them a well-entrenched Hindi Weeklies run for their money. Though print media has been his forte, his tryst with audio-visual medium makes an impressive reading either. This is his rare attribute in the sense that his printed work and truly outstanding *interviews on the screen were kept in hand*. The highlight in this medium has been his special interviews with almost all Indian Prime Ministers from Indira Gandhi down to the present incumbent Atal Behari Vajpeyi. Since last 25 years, he has been contributing for National Broadcasting and Telecasting Channels which includes anchoring, commenting, producing, writing and editing. This is not the only aspect of Alok Mehta. Despite always on the toes in the journalistic activity he has not left his only love -writing. He has several books published to his credit.

While engrossed in print media, he never lost sight of audio-visual upsurge

and kept pace with the changing technology in the field of journalism. In an international training programme of voice of America at Chiangmai (Thailand) in February 2000, he took training in Video Journalism with most sophisticated digital camera. During the workshop, he worked independently with digital camera, wrote scripts, edited and produced current affairs programmes. Renowned U.S. media consultant Michael Rosenblum noted his works with utmost satisfaction.

He splashed himself all over on audio-visual scene through Doordarshan and Indian T.V. networks. Many of his interviews long ago with high and mighty of India and Abroad in TV are still remembered and talked about. The leaders whom he interviewed make a

About his journalistic manner and guiding formula he said "I believe in non partisan journalism where our job is to inform." General impression about the Hindi print media is that it is always attached to some school of thought or backing from some vested interest. But Alok Mehta with his indisputable style established the impartial image in Hindi journalism. He said "Country is important not the group. I have always tried to bring the truth to the forefront and never tried to sensationalize the news. We were the first people who exposed fodder scam in Bihar but we have not sensationalized it. We believe in responsible journalism. We do not have any prejudices and I believe our job is to inform only. We are here to decipher the

was the firm belief that Hindi magazine will do good because Hindi people does not have platform to air their views. I have shared this idea to Vinod Mehta, and the idea of Outlook got through and I became editor of this magazine.

It is a general perception that editor and publisher used to be at loggerheads. But Alok shares a unique relationship with managing editor and publisher of Outlook, Vinod Mehta. Perhaps having identical name make a lot of people misunderstand both of them as real brothers. He smiles and tells : we both half form different States. As Vinod belongs to Punjab and I come from MP. But we live like brothers because on many crucial issues our viewpoints gel very well. You can say our wavelength usually complement each other.

Alok went applaud for his critical acumen and with his hard hitting stories and oratory skills he has unearthed the information and unsparingly divulged the scams. About the turning point of his career he said, "Working as a resident editor of Navbharat Times, Patna was one of the most challenging assignment of my career. He has interviewed almost all the dignitaries and whose pen use to nail all the relevant political and social interest that is of national interest.
